Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to Strictly Financial Ltd, so we've developed a Privacy Policy that covers how we collect, use, disclose, transfer, and store your information. We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data are treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

1. What we collect

We collect certain information or data about you when you use www.strictlyfinancial.com or contact us using the website forms. This policy gives you information about how we treat personal information received from our website visitors.

We collect:

- Personal information that you provide to us (such as name, postal address, telephone number, email address and payment details if you are purchasing from us) if you contact Strictly Financial Ltd (irrespective of method of that contact)
- Details of which version of web browser you used as well as information on how you use the site, by using cookies and page tagging techniques.

We have a number of lawful reasons that mean we can use your personal information. One of these is something called 'legitimate interests'. Broadly speaking Legitimate Interests means we can process your personal information if:

- We have a genuine and legitimate reason
- We are not harming any of your rights and interests

This information helps us to:

- Send you our newsletters from time to time
- Ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your device
- Provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes or where it is in our legitimate interest to do this and when these interests do not override your rights
- Carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us

- Allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so and
- Notify you about changes to our service.

This information can be viewed by authorised people in Strictly Financial Ltd and our IT suppliers, The Engine Room, to:

- Improve the site by monitoring how you use it
- Gather feedback to improve our services, for example our email alerts
- Respond to any feedback you send us.

2. Where your information is stored

We store your information on secure servers within the European Economic Area (EEA).

3. Keeping your information secure

We have procedures and security features in place to keep your information secure once we receive it. This is detailed in our Data Protection and Security Policy.

4. Disclosing your information

We may pass on your personal information if we have a legal obligation to do so, or if we have to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements. This may include disclosing to other companies and organisations in connection with fraud protection and credit risk reduction. We won't share your information with any other organisations for marketing, market research or commercial purposes, and we don't pass on your details to other websites.
